

Symphonic Band and Adv. Wind Symphony Auditions:

Major Scales

Any format you want

Play only as fast as you can play cleanly

If wanting Adv. Wind Symphony, prepare as many 2 octave scales as you can

Tone will be assessed

Intermediate and Advanced Jazz

Winds:

The aforementioned scales will count in the Jazz audition

The short selection (see attached) choose the appropriate part for what you want to play

Bass:

Major Scales

Short Selection (see attached)

Be prepared to create a walking bass line from simple chords

Guitar and Piano:

Major Scales

Short Selection (see attached)

Be prepared to comp over simple chords

Drums:

Swing – be prepared to play a swing feel behind the wind figures in the short selection (see attached), focus on kicking the horn's rhythms.

Latin – be prepared to play a Latin feel of your choice (Samba, Bossa, etc)

Vocal:

Prepare a jazz standard of your choice

Adv. Percussion Ensemble

Scales – any format you like. Play only as fast as you can play cleanly.

One selection of your choice on the instrument of your choice:

Marimba, Vibe, Snare, Timpani
