Concurrent Enrollment

What is concurrent enrollment?

Concurrent Enrollment offers high school students the opportunity to take college-level courses for Utah Valley University and American Fork High School credit simultaneously, or concurrently. Concurrent Enrollment (CE) students register for the class at both the high school and UVU. While students earn high school credit, they also earn UVU credit which is recorded on a permanent college transcript. Students will need to pay a one-time \$35 fee to apply for admissions as a Concurrent Enrollment student, and will then be required to pay \$5 per College credit hour that they are enrolling in through UVU.
