

# 12<sup>th</sup> Grade English Options

**English 12: Full Year, 1 Credit hour**

**English 1010: Full Year, 1 Credit hour, and Concurrent enrollment  
(3 UVU English credits).**

In order to be eligible to enroll in this course you must:

- Be a Senior
- Have A's and B's in both 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> grade English courses
- Have an ACT Score of 19+ in English and 19+ in Reading
  - Or have an ACT score of 20+ in English and 18+ in Reading.
  - Or have an ACT score of 18+ in English and 20+ in Reading.
- You may substitute ACT scores with a UVU Accuplacer Reading & Sentence Skills Test.

**Students must complete an English 1010 Application to be enrolled in this course (available through a Google Form beginning April 12<sup>th</sup>).**

**English 1010/2010: Full Year, 1 Credit hour, and Concurrent enrollment (6 UVU English credits).**

In order to be eligible to enroll in this course you must:

- Be a Senior
- Have A's and B's in both 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> grade English courses
- Have an ACT Score of 19+ in English and 19+ in Reading
  - Or have an ACT score of 20+ in English and 18+ in Reading.
  - Or have an ACT score of 18+ in English and 20+ in Reading.
- You may substitute ACT scores with a UVU Accuplacer Reading & Sentence Skills Test.

**Students must complete an English 1010 Application to be enrolled in this course (available through a Google Form beginning April 12<sup>th</sup>).**
