10th grade Math Course Options for the typical student

Sec 1 (repeat)

A Sec 1 repeater:

Did not master the essentials from Sec 1 (might be a knowledge gap created by attendance).

Sec 2 Essentials

An essentials student:

- Struggled with the essential standards and demonstrates minimal proficiency.
- May have gaps in knowledge of the essentials in this course or previous courses.
- Is not placed in this course for behavioral or attendance challenges.
- Requires a teacher recommendation and is added to a schedule by counselor only.

Sec 2 Regular

A regular student:

- Will be faced with a significant challenge due to the jump in mathematical difficulty found in Sec 2 compared to Sec 1 and the transition to high school life/demands. (extracurricular, work, content, greater homework demands, social life changes, etc.)
- Needs to be prepared for homework.
- Preps students for 1010/1040/1050, pre-calculus, and AP stats in the senior year

Sec 2 Honors

An honors student:

- Intends to take AP Calculus in high school.
- Needs to be prepared for nightly homework, 30 minutes on average.
- Demonstrates resilience, persistence, advocacy, advanced problem solving skills, and a deep understanding of the essential standards in Secondary Math 1.
