Rob Smith and Rhonda Bromley from Alpine School District, presented bond history and future concerns to city patrons, district employees, PTSA and SCC members. Meeting started at 1:00 and ended at 2:15.

SCC Meeting began at 2:15 with Principal Carolyn Merrill handing out copy of School Trust Land report that was submitted.

Principal Merrill addressed issues presented by SCC members. Driving range being moved south and improvements added so road closed until construction completed. Adds more parking at north end of range.

Ron Ulloa concerns about students not getting enough driving range time. Principal explained teachers doubled up students to drive and they are required to drive so many hours so all students got driving hours in. Mr. Ulloa said some students sent to class instead of driving. Holly Clayton explained half of students take drivers ed. class and other half take study skills class.
