e are looking forward to Parent Teacher Conference on February 13<sup>th</sup>, from 3:00 until 7:30 pm. We encourage you to track how your student is doing in Skyward, where you can view attendance, assignments and grades. We are transitioning more towards electronic communication to save time and money. However, if you would like a paper copy of your student's report card, you will be able to print a copy from Skyward or just

come by one of the offices and we will gladly print one for you.

All juniors have the opportunity to take the ACT on Tuesday, March 5<sup>th</sup>, at no cost to the student. The ACT is used for college admission and most universities require an ACT score. By doing so on March 5th, one of the hurdles of getting into college has been cleared. Since this is not a mandatory school day for seniors and sophomores, we are asking them to use this day for activities such as university or college visits, career exploration, job shadowing or visiting a vocational training center. If seniors and sophomores should decide to attend school this day, they should not be at the school before noon, so as to minimize the noise during testing. Lunch for all students will be served from 12:00 noon-12:45 pm. All students are encouraged to use the remainder of the day to work with teachers on make-up work, turning in missing assignments, making up absences/tardies in Attendance School or any other additional help necessary.

We would especially like to celebrate the academic success of our students and teachers with regard to our UCASS test scores totaling a composite score of 523. Any score over 470 is considered very good, but as you can see in the adjacent chart, is the second high-
