

AUP in teacher Gradebook Overview

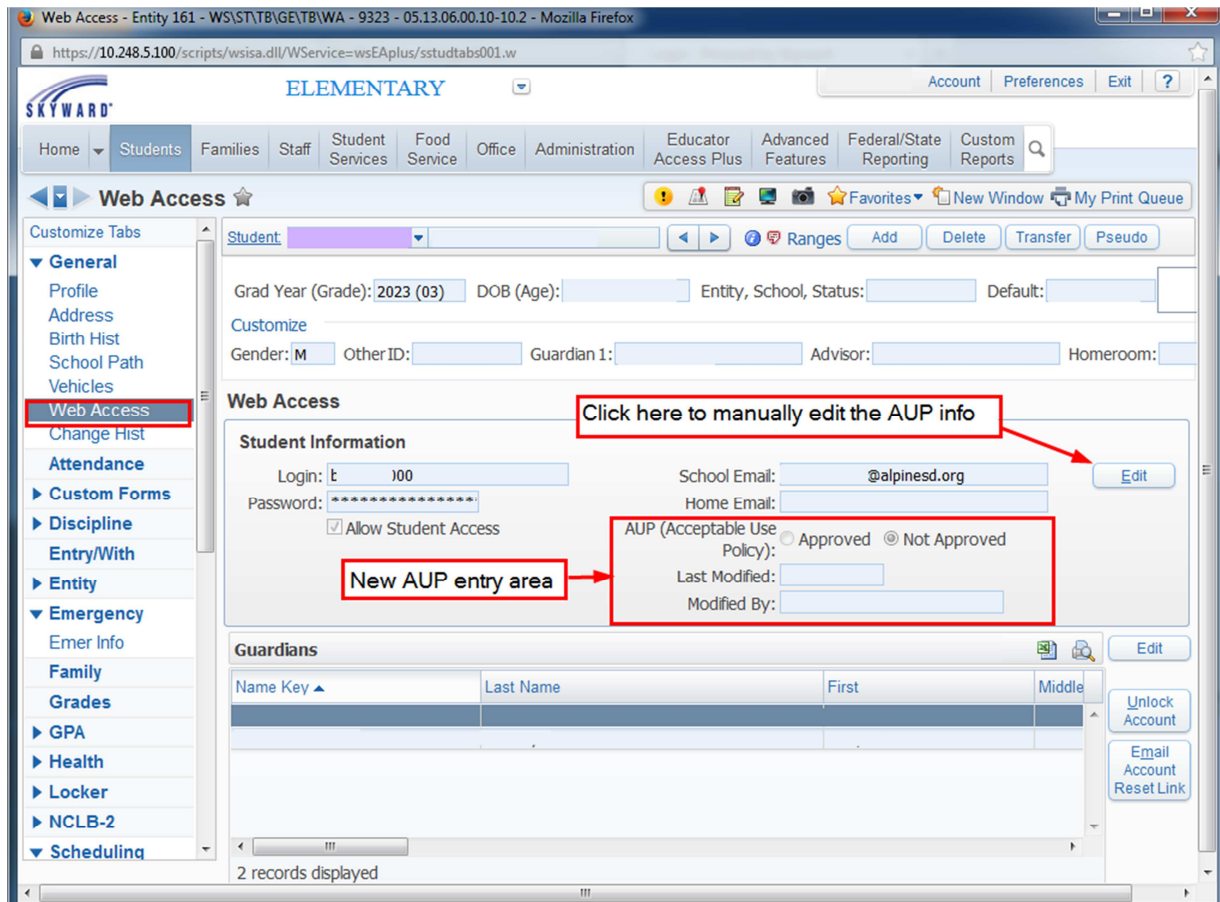
Teachers will shortly see the student's AUP status in their grade books. Office personnel will also no longer be using Custom Forms to make manual changes to the AUP. Current AUP statuses will be moved from Custom Forms to the new area.

Once enabled, this is the area where AUPs will now be entered. All the AUP statuses from the past will be migrated over to this new area.
