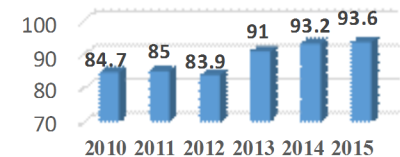

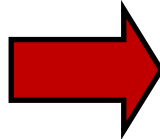




# PGHS: We Are A Professional Learning Community

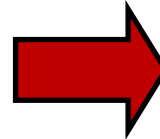
### Graduation Rate



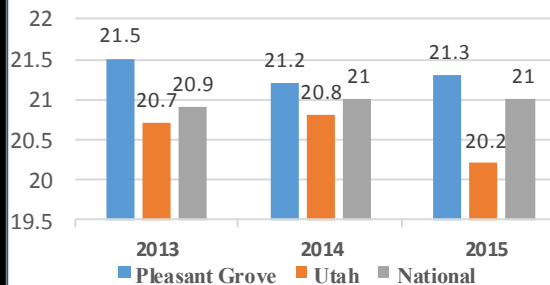
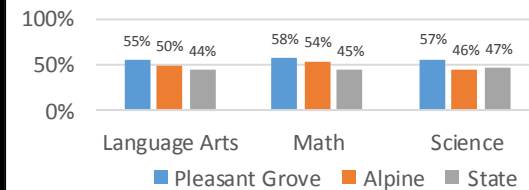

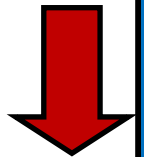
