### Important Upcoming Dates

**Wed. April 13<sup>th</sup> Deadline for Seniors to apply for the \$1,000 'Spirit of the Viking Scholarship.'** Applications are available in the Counseling Office. You'll need to submit a copy of your official transcript, 1,000 word essay, and a letter of recommendation. Turn applications in to the Counseling Office by 2:30pm.

**Wed. April 13<sup>th</sup> Deadline for Marie Bone Female Athlete Scholarship.** Female Senior girls may apply. Applicants must have a 3.7 GPA or higher, submit a copy of high school transcript, a letter of recommendation and a 1,000 word essay. Forms are in the Counseling Office and must be returned by 2:30pm on deadline day.

**Fri. April 15<sup>th</sup> Deadline for Latter-day Pioneer Scholarship by 5pm.** This is for Seniors who are 1<sup>st</sup> generation converts to the church or have parents that have joined the Church in the student's lifetime. **Wed. - Honors Cords: Gold Cords - Student must have a cumulative GPA of 3.95+ by the end of Term 3. Silver Cords - Student must have cumulative GPA of 3.70 – 3.949 by the end of Term 3. Term 3 ends March 18<sup>th</sup>.
