Important Upcoming Dates

Wed. April 20th Deadline for the \$500 PGHS CTE Pathway Scholarship. Applicants must be graduating Seniors who have completed a Career Pathway, have a min. 3.0 GPA, and applied for full time admission to an eligible college or university. Forms are in the Counseling Office and must be returned by 2:30pm on the deadline day.

Wed. April 20th Deadline for the Marie Bone Female Athlete Scholarship. Senior girls graduating with 2016 class who have a 3.7 gpa or higher may apply. Submit transcript, letter of recommendation, involved in school or community sports, and write a 1,000 word or less essay. Apply in the Counseling Office and return by 2:30pm on the 20th.

- All fines and fees paid
- All required credits met
- Take and pass the Civics Test.
 - This is required by the state and new this year. To take the test, please click on the 'Flag' link on the main page of the school website. This will take you directly to the test. The students may take it as many times as needed to pass.

- Honors Cords: Gold Cords - Student must have a cumulative GPA of 3.95+ by the end of Term 3. Silver Cords - Student must have cumulative GPA of 3.70 – 3.949 by the end of Term 3. Term 3 ends March 18th.
