Important Graduation Information

Seniors MUST have the following done to graduate:

- All NC's cleared
- All fines and fees paid
- All required credits met
- Take and pass the required civics test.
 - This is required by the state and new this year. To take the test, please click on the 'Flag' link on the main page of the school website. This will take you directly to the test. The students may take it as many times as needed to pass.
- Honors Cords: Gold Cords - Student must have a cumulative GPA of 3.95+ by the end of Term 3. Silver Cords - Student must have cumulative GPA of 3.70 – 3.949 by the end of Term 3. Term 3 ends March 18th. Cords may be purchased from the Finance Office. They are \$6.00.
- May 26th 8am Mandatory graduation practice in the PGHS Auditorium. Cap and gown distribution will be held from 10:00am - 3:00pm in the Student Center.

- May 27th PGHS Graduation Day. Graduates should arrive at UVU-UCCU Center at 6:30pm. Ceremony will begin at 7:30pm. Please allow adequate time for heavy traffic in the area.
