

PGHS Emergency Plan

The Alpine School District requires schools to be accountable for their students in emergency situations. This means if we had an emergency at PGHS, until the officials at Alpine School District give permission for students to be released from school, students must remain under the supervision of the school. For safety reasons, and accounting to parents, students will not be permitted to leave, nor will cars be allowed to leave the parking areas.

The school's safety team works each year to compile an effective safety and emergency plan. It provides detailed instruction to faculty and students for any type of emergency from evacuation to in-school sheltering.

Should there ever be a time when we could not go back into the school after an earthquake, fire, or some other incident, faculty and students would:

1. Evacuate the School
2. Account for students
3. Students will remain on the football field until they are checked out by a parent.

Parents/guardians can check a student out by either driving to a check out point by the Veterans Memorial Pool via Locust Avenue, or by walking to the ticket booth gate near the auditorium. For inclement weather Students A-L will evacuate to the LDS church located on 200 S Loader. Students M-Z will evacuate to the church located on 200 S 400 E. Check out procedures will be in place. Your cooperation, along with a calm and orderly behavior will be an asset to the situation. The PGHS safety team works hand in hand with both police and fire officials on a regular basis. Faculty, staff and students are trained at the beginning of each new school year with several practice drills during the year.
