

PGHS School Community Council Meeting Notes for Mar. 29, 2017

Minute Approval: Motion made by Amanda, seconded by Mark. Vote was unanimous to approve.

Budget Discussion and Review of New Proposal: Our proposed budget for the 2017/2018 school year includes Leadership team development, Chromebooks for the English Dept., funding for an additional advocate/Spanish speaker, funding for a math intern and we will continue to fund AP classes, English Graders and Advocates/East Shore.

Dr. Stewart explained his need for leadership team development by reviewing the vision of Alpine District, including 3 basic teams. 1) Leadership, 2) teacher (including collaboration) and 3) intervention. Two of these three teams are sufficiently in place at PGHS. Dr. Stewart is concerned about getting a great leadership team in place, including administrators, teachers and counselors.

Mark asked Dr. Stewart to task the leadership team with concrete proposals for the SCC for next year.

Mark made a motion to vote on the budget as outlined. Amanda seconded the motion. The budget passed unanimously.

Discussion was made about SCC elections in May and who would be staying on the council. Garth, Amanda, Cheryl, Heather, and Cristie were all willing and able to stay. Cindy was done with her service.

Cheryl made the motion to adjourn and Heather seconded.
