# Parking

Student parking stickers are available for **11th and 12th grade students only**, with one permit allowed per student. Cost is \$10 per permit. Prior year stickers/parking passes are not valid. Parking permit applications must be completed online. **Please be prepared to upload an electronic (pdf or jpeg) copy of your vehicle registration and a photograph of the vehicle.** Applications will be reviewed daily for approval beginning August 1st. All school fees must be take care of in order to purchase a parking permit. <u>Click here</u> to access the online application. **Please note that having a parking sticker does not guarantee a parking stall.** 

Students with a parking pass must park in designated areas (<u>parking map</u>). Parking tickets are \$15 per violation. Excessive violations will result in a boot fee of \$50. When booted all parking tickets and boot fine will have to be paid before the boot will be removed.

# **School Community Council**

We have 9 openings for our School Community Council parent positions this year. Serving on our School Community Council is a wonderful way for parents to contribute and help improve academic performance at our school and to see all of the amazing things happening at Lehi High School.

Schools receive an annual dividend from the school trust lands and every year our council decides how these funds will be used. The council reviews data and assists in preparing a school improvement plan to maximize student achievement. Councils also act in an advisory capacity to school and school district administrations.

Membership terms are for two years and parent members must have a student attending Lehi High School for at least one of the two years during the term of service. An election will be held Aug 25-27th for the 9 open council positions if needed.

# **School Pictures**

**Yearbook** pictures for all students (including Seniors) will be taken by Lifetouch Photography during English classes from August 19-20. Students without an English class will need to make sure they have their picture taken during these days. Senior boys are expected to wear a white shirt, purple tie, and suit coat, which will be provided by Lifetouch. Senior girls will be expected to wear a solid black shirt, provided by Lifetouch. Girls may choose to wear their own shirt, as long as it is completely black (no designs or logos) and complies with the dress code.

Make up pictures will be taken September 23.

If you are unable to have your yearbook picture taken on one of these dates, you will need to make arrangements with Lifetouch Photography to have your picture taken before September 30th, or **your picture will not appear in the yearbook**.
