LIBYAN CIVIL WAR

TUESDAY, AUGUST 23

TRIPOLI, LIBYA - FOR THE PAST SIX MONTHS, REBELLIONS HAVE BEEN RAGING ACROSS THE MIDDLE EAST, NORTH AFRICA, AND EUROPE. ONE REBELLION IN PARTICULAR HAS SPARKED GROWING INTEREST IN WHAT WILL BECOME OF LIBYA. IN 1951, MOAMMAR GADHAFI ABOLISHED THE LIBYAN CONSTITUTION, AND SINCE 1969 RULED AS DICTATOR IN HIS COUNTRY.

ON FEBRUARY 25, 2011, EVERYTHING CHANGED. PROTESTS AGAINST THE GADHAFI REGIME BEGAN TO RISE AND IN RETALIATION, GADHAFI FORCED HIS MILITARY AGAINST THE REBELS TO DESTROY THEIR PROTESTS ONCE AND FOR ALL. IN FACT, THE VERY OPPOSITE HAPPENED. THE PROTESTS ESCALATED INTO AN UPRISING AND ALL OUT CIVIL WAR AGAINST THE LIBYAN GOVERNMENT.

THE REBEL FORCES SOON ESTABLISHED THEIR OWN GOVERNMENT BASED IN BENGHAZI, TITLED THE NATION TRANSITIONAL COUNCIL. THEIR ULTIMATE GOAL: OVERTHROW GADHAFI. IN MARCH, GADHAFI FORCES STORMED THE REBELS AND ATTACKED BENGHAZI, PUSHING THE REBELS AWAY, BUT UNABLE TO FULLY SQUASH THEM.

AFTER MONTHS OF WAR AND UNREST, THE REBELS FINALLY GAINED THE UPPER HAND. ON AUGUST 23, REBEL FORCES STORMED GADHAFI'S COMPOUND. THEY SET FIRE TO WHATEVER THEY COULD TOUCH AND STOLE VALUABLE ITEMS FROM THE DICTATOR'S OWN BEDROOM. TUESDAY MARKED A GREAT WIN FOR THE REBELS, BUT MOAMMAR GADHAFI WAS NOWHERE TO BE FOUND.


EVEN IN HIDING, GADHAFI ISN¹T ABOUT TO GO DOWN. HE RECENTLY RELEASED THIS STATEMENT TO TRY AND STOP THE REBELLION SO THAT HE MIGHT REMAIN IN POWER: "ALL LIBYANS MUST BE PRESENT IN TRIPOLI, YOUNG MEN, TRIBAL MEN AND WOMEN MUST SWEEP THROUGH TRIPOLI AND COMB IT FOR TRAITORS. I HAVE BEEN OUT A BIT IN TRIPOLI DISCREETLY, WITHOUT BEING SEEN BY PEOPLE, AND . . . I DID NOT FEEL THAT TRIPOLI WAS IN DANGER."

UNFORTUNATELY FOR GADHAFI, THE REBELS AREN'T ABOUT TO BACK DOWN AND WITH THE WAY THE TIDES HAVE TURNED IN FAVOR OF THE OPPOSITION TO GADHAFI'S REGIME, THEY WILL OVERPOWER THOSE THAT TRY TO STOP THEM. IT WILL ONLY BE A MATTER OF TIME BEFORE GADHAFI'S RULE COMES TO A TRIUMPHANT, YET BLOODY END.

EXPERTS SAY THAT EVEN IF LIBYA FALLS INTO THE HANDS OF THE REBELS, OIL WILL NOT IMMEDIATELY BE DISTRIBUTED TO THE REST OF THE WORLD. IN COMPLIANCE, THE COST OF OIL WILL NOT IMMEDIATELY FALL. IT COULD TAKE SEVERAL YEARS FOR THE PRICE OF OIL TO RETURN TO ITS LEVELS PRIOR TO THE REBELLION.


