  - Harvest Elementary
  - Pony Express Elementary
  - Saratoga Shores ElementaryIf there are multiple candidates from the same area, an election will be held from May 14-May 16
  
- **How much time will it take?**  
A total of 6-8 meetings will be held throughout the year. The meetings will be approximately 2 hours each.
