Gaming Club

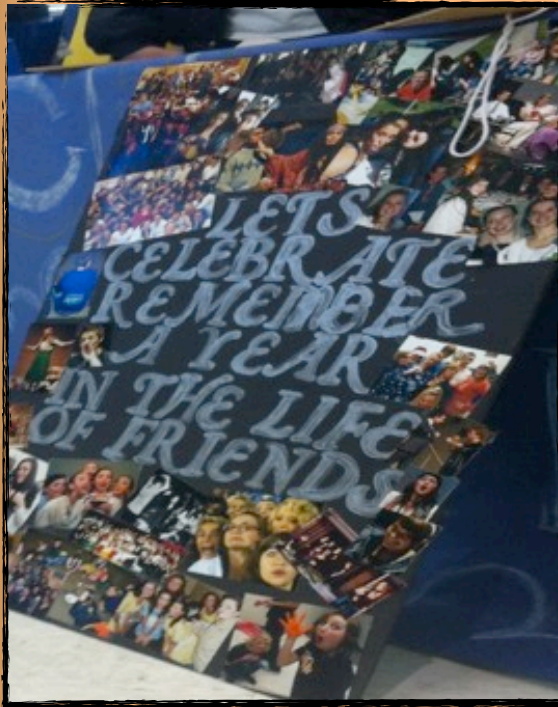
