One man, by the name of Jake Heggie, composed an insightful, surprisingly joyous album based on the unfortunate series of events. Leslie Haskin, is a survivor of this event. Leslie was living a good life. She had a loving family, and a great job. She was the executive manager for one of the top insurance companies. She worked on the 36th floor of the first tower. Physically she survived, but mentally she was lost. She suffered PTSD after the attack and had to be hospitalized leaving her family hopeless and homeless. Today, Haskin has dedicated her life to helping others. She is the founder and director of Safe Hugs Ministries, a sought after public speaker and the author of four books. Her recovery is a story of healing through a renewed devotion to her faith. "For me that day marks a rebirth," says Haskin. "I still struggle with being in tall buildings and stairwells, but God had me survive for a reason. And every time I can talk to people about my experiences and give them hope, I realize what it is."

So throughout this week, pray for those who have left this earth because of this event. But also pray for those who have regained hope and created a new life for themselves.

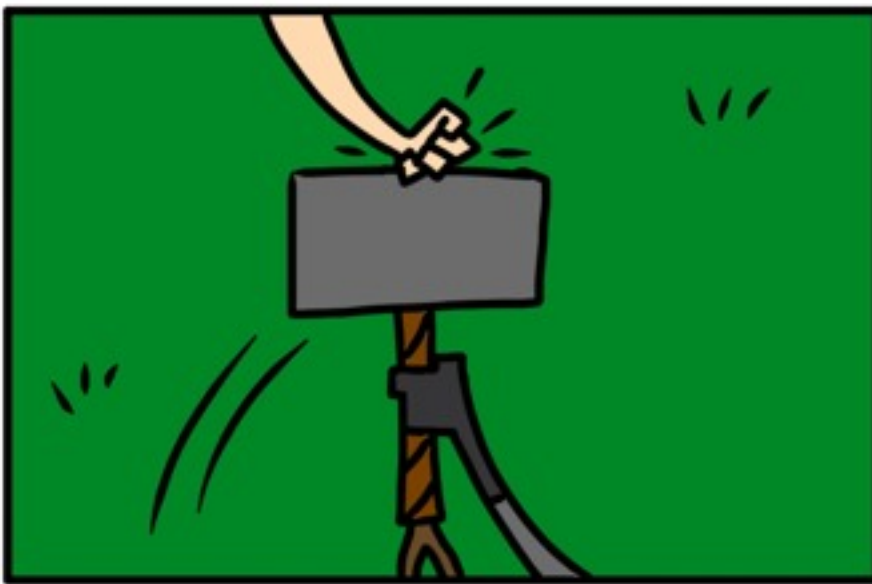
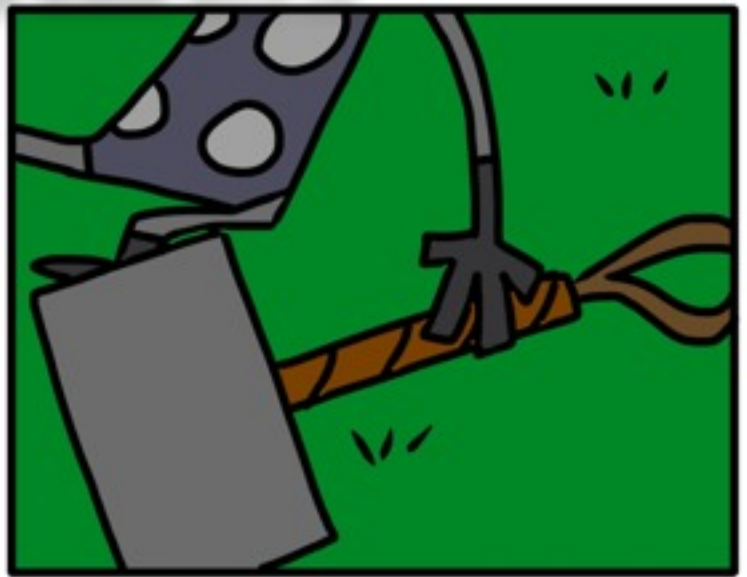
