Meal Charging Policy/Procedures – for Parents

Parents will be responsible and accountable for monitoring their student/students account balance and assure that funds are available for meal purchases.

Students will be reminded when their balance is getting low and/or out of funds. Letters will be sent home to parents weekly, to be informed of any negative balance concerns that require a payment for an elementary student. A secondary student may also receive a letter, if charges accrue.

In an effort to help you and your student/students have a positive experience relating to school meals, we would like to make you aware of a beneficial feature provided to you by Alpine School District, it is MyPaymentsPlus.

MyPaymentsPlus is a secure online payment system. It provides an easy-to-use and efficient way to make payments quickly and securely. In most instances payments are posted immediately, but could take up to 24 hours to post to the student account.

MyPaymentsPlus also allows for the ability to receive **FREE** balance email alerts to inform you when your student/students meal account is getting low.

There is **NO** charge to use the online payment and/or balance alert features.
