SENIOR DINNER DANCE—COST \$25

The Senior Dinner Dance will be held at the UVU Ballroom. The time is from 5:30-10pm. Dinner will be served at 6pm. This is not a date dance but is semi-formal and is for WHS seniors only. The evening will include an amazing dinner, followed by a night of awards, dancing and fun. Tickets to this event must be purchased by May 12th. No exceptions or refunds will be granted. Tickets will NOT be sold at the door. Seniors will have their choice of Roasted Chicken Caprese or Cheese Enchilada for their dinner selection.

May 24th

GRADUATION PRACTICE

Seniors MUST report to the Main Gym for Graduation Practice at 8am on May 24th. You will not be going to UVU for practice. Seniors will need to be cleared for graduation by this time so you can attend practice. It is important for you to understand what will happen at graduation.

May 24th

CAP & GOWN DISTRIBUTION

Cap & gowns will be distributed from 11am – 1pm in the main gym. This will be immediately following the graduation practice, which will also be held in the main gym. (see above) In order to receive your cap and gown, all fees must be paid and all grades and NC's must be cleared. Yearbooks will be handed out immediately following distribution to those who have purchased a yearbook.

The Yearbook Stomp will be held in the Commons Area from 8-10pm.

THUNDER AWARDS

Thunder Awards will be held in the auditorium from 6-8pm.

May 19th

SENIOR LAGOON DAY—COST \$50

Seniors will be going to Lagoon. Buses are scheduled to leave WHS at 8am and return around 6pm. No private vehicles will be allowed in the park. Students must ride the buses up and back. Students will be responsible to bring money for their own lunch. Tickets are presale only and must be purchased from the finance office by May 12th. No exceptions or refunds will be granted. There is a limit of tickets and seats on the buses so don't wait to buy your ticket!

The doors will open at 9:30pm. **If you purchase a ticket at the door, the cost will increase to \$40.** Comedy Sportz will be starting the night off at WHS with a comedy show (10pm in the auditorium) – seniors then travel by bus to Boondocks in Draper. There will be all you can eat pizza from 11pm to midnight and unlimited drinks throughout the night. Buses will return to Westlake at approximately 4am.
