

1 ASD provided funding for four FTEs (full time educators) allowing Westlake to increase course offerings

2 ASD provided an additional Assistant Registrar to expedite transcripts, enroll students, etc.

3 ASD provided 40 tables and 80 chairs to convert two rooms into classrooms

4 ASD provided a mobile computer lab (40 machines, cart, and charger) to increase access

5 ASD added two serving carts and personnel to decrease wait time at lunch

6 ASD partnered with Chick-Fil-A and Costa Vida to provide additional lunch options

7 ASD added eight additional lunch tables for seating

8 Created smaller than average class sizes

- 84 classes with 20 or fewer students
- 167 classes with 25 or fewer students
- 328 classes with 30 or fewer students

9 Organized efforts to reduce lunch congestion with distribution of serving areas

10 Created three lunch sessions, each averaging 1,200 students

11 Stationed advocates and administrators during lunch and passing periods to help with flow
