Mr. Twitchell shared data from the 2014-15 school year. Westlake is an academically based school and is trying to get students college ready. An area to improve is math—which now we have Mr. Huff as a TAA and will be able to spend quality time with the math teachers and develop a plan to improve student scores. He will also be working with all the new math teachers on a monthly basis. Mr. Mansfield is currently cleaning up our graduation rate and making sure we are the cleanest and most efficient that we can be.

Attendance Policy

- Westlake has tightened up our attendance policy!
- Parents will now only have 10 days to excuse unexcused absences.
- This is not something that is new...we are just enforcing district policy.
- Coaches and/or advisors MUST get the excusal list to the attendance office in a timely manner so parents know ahead of time if and when their student will be school excused.
- Parents feel that conditioning classes are the biggest problem!

- More attendance school sessions will be offered. It will be Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday mornings for FREE and Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday after school for \$3.
- The best and most encouraged way to make up the NC is through the teacher who gave the student the NC. This is the preferred way.
- As we go through the year, we will continue to tighten up the attendance policy. Students must be in class to be successful in school.

Trustlands

- Mr. Twitchell explained to the council there should be roughly a 17% increase to the amount that was planned for in the spring, which should be about \$10,000.
- It was written into the Trustland plan that if there were additional monies, it would be used for a computer lab.
- Mr. Twitchell will have the exact dollar amount at the next meeting.

Opening Schedule

- Opening House—August 17th 4-7pm
 - o Clubs/Organizations will be in the commons area
 - o Student Council Tours will begin every 15 minutes from the commons area
 - As part of the tour, they will go to the auditorium for a short 6-8 minute video where it will be some "helpful hint", "fun facts", "did you know", as well as some motivational clips of Westlake!
 - o After the auditorium, a tour will be given.
 - o This will cycle through group after group.
 - o The finance, counseling, main, and athletic offices will all be open.
- Back to School Night—August 31st 5-8pm
 - o 5-7pm Bells will run to give it an 8-period structure
 - o 7-8pm w/out bells for an open house feel
 - o This night is for parents to meet teachers and understand the classroom expectations.
 - o This is in place of Parent/Teacher Conference in September.
