- I. No quorum today, so minutes will need to be sent out and approved via email
- II. Video streaming update
 - A. District decided to go with a company that will give us a package deal. Other schools in the district are going with the same company. Cost for Westlake: approx. \$3,000 total. The video company will take over and broadcast any game in Alpine School District. Cost for Westlake parents to access the streaming is \$9 a month or \$69.99 a year.
- III. 2020-21 Trustlands Feedback/Discussion
 - A. Master Schedule--Need 83 FTE
 - B. ASD allocation--2,333 students, which equals 80 FTE
 - C. Westlake will be 3 FTE short
 - D. Anticipated Trustlands 2020-21 \$325,239
 - 1. Needed advocates \$140,000
 - 2. 1/7ths \$185,239
 - a) \$185,239 = 2.5 FTE
 - b) = $16 \frac{1}{7}$ ths
 - E. Current accounts
 - 1. General Admin = \$120,000
 - 2. Student Activity = \$60,000
 - 3. Building Rental = \$25,000
 - 4. Admin Tech = \$140,000
- IV. Items from Council Members
 - A. Focus in classes on Resilient Disposition for the remainder of the year
 - 1. Suicide prevention evening with Dr. Greg Hudnall was a success.
 - 2. Perhaps conduct discussions about resilience in different periods, so students can experience the discussion with different teachers
 - 3. Shared "Coping with Loss" PowerPoint with principals at Lake Mountain and Vista Heights
 - B. Happy with weekly Principal Twitchell communication
 - C. Go to the Trustlands website for information about School Community Council
 - D. Comfortable with how the school handles lock down, lock out, etc.
 - E. Suicide Prevention night a success and proposed to have on a yearly basis

- F. Coach Clark has retired. Westlake has hired Sam Kekuaokalani to take his place. He will teach weight classes as well as be a potential assistant coach for football and/or basketball.
- G. Westlake will open a wellness center for students in our building, structured similar to Palo Alto High School and Desert Hills High School wellness centers. A clinician and therapist will be in the wellness center.
