Update from Principal Twitchell--4/20/2020



1. **Important Graduation Survey:** Alpine School District has sent out a Graduation survey. It is REALLY important that you take some time to respond to this survey, if you have a senior attending Westlake. It is equally important that your student respond. The student survey will come to their school account and sometimes students do not monitor their school account, so please have them watch for this survey. The voices of parents and

students are important to us; and Alpine School District will make a decision accordingly.

- 2. **Wednesday or Thursday:** I will be sending an a very detailed e-mail late Wednesday or early Thursday regarding the following:
 - Results of the survey and how graduation will take place
 - Cap and Gown pick up dates and times
 - Honor cords, medals and other academic recognition distribution
 - Virtual try-out update for next year's classes/programs
 - Yearbook distribution dates and procedures
- 3. **Senior Clearance for Graduation:** There are several things that seniors need to do to graduate and/or get their cap and gown:
 - Seniors need to make sure that they have taken the Civics Test. This is a State requirement. If your senior student has not taken this test yet, then please contact your student's counselor.
 - Seniors need to have all classes that were failed prior to 4th quarter of this year made up.
 - Seniors need to have all fines resolved.
- 4. **Graduation Speakers:** Westlake allows all seniors who are in good standing try-out for some of the speaking portions of graduation. Please see the attachment at the bottom for a flyer on how students can try-out to speak at graduation.

Reminders

Student pick up of items: Teachers will be contacting students in their respective classes to coordinate pick up projects. General pick up of items from lockers is an on-going process.

Student return of items: We will be coordinating the return of items in May. We want to wait until class work is completed.

Refunds:

- Prom: Unfortunately, we are not able to reschedule Prom at this time. We looking at possible Summer options, but unless Social Distancing is lifted, then it is really hard to hold a Prom. If you would like a refund for Prom, then please contact the Finance Office. If we are able to hold Prom in the summer, then we will notify students and make tickets available.
- Spring Athletics: We are refunding the \$100 Participation Fee for Spring Athletics. We are also refunding an additional \$50 that was earmarked for travel, officials, and other game related things. If your student received a shirt or other apparel or equipment and is keeping these items, then these fees are not being refunded. Coaches will be contacting their players regarding what specific fees are being refunded and coordinating return of items that athletes do not want.
- Trips: We are still in the process of getting refunds from agencies. As these come in, the advisors will be reaching out to their students with procedures for individual student refunds.

Grades: ASD is exploring alternative grading procedures. The intent is to "do no harm" to students. ASD School Board will be reviewing proposals, and you will be notified of these changes on Wednesday. ASD is working on a fair process that takes a lot of things into consideration. We understand that this is a really bizarre situation, and there is a lot of stress and anxiety regarding grades.

Grab and go Meals: You should have received notification of changes to to Grab and Go Meal distribution process. I am attaching a summary for your reference in case you missed it.

Field Use: The stadium is open from about 8:00 am - 6:00 pm. We ask that you respect the governor's social distancing guidelines. We have had trouble with dogs pooping on the field, damage to the turf, food on the turf (which invalidates the warranty on the turf), knocked over garbage cans, vandalism and general misuse of the facility.

Please help us monitor use, so we can offer the use of the stadium for students and patrons. Please adhere to the following:

- Dogs are NOT allowed in the stadium.
- Keep social distancing
- Group practices or pick up games are NOT allowed (this violates social distancing and the UHSAA rules of their Moratorium)
- No food
- Only water on the turf

We do not want to have to close the facility like many municipalities have done with playgrounds.
