one of this year's changes to Westlake is the introduction of our new principal, Dr. Christian Smith. We had the chance to sit down with him to understand who he is and his plans for Westlake. Based on our conversation, we think we're in for a great year.

When Dr. Smith finished high school in Alabama, he didn't originally plan on becoming a teacher. His father had done well with a family business of industrial piping, and Dr. Smith planned on following in his footsteps. However, shortly after graduation, Dr. Smith went on a life-changing trip to visit a business school in Kentucky. During this trip, both Dr. Smith and his father realized that business was not for him. On the way back, they happened to be passing by a school in Lexington. They stopped to see what it took to become a teacher and

soon he was an English teacher in Kentucky. After moving from Kentucky to Utah, he taught English at Lehi High. He continued his career in education, most recently as the

principal of Polaris High.

During our discussion, Smith emphasized the idea of bringing the school closer together. He stated that when he was growing up, schools were the center of

students' lives. In the modern age, with more kids getting and the Internet connecting us to each other in different ways, the feeling of community is not as strong in our schools. Dr. Smith plans to bring our student body closer together through tailgate parties, lunch discussions, and Westlake swag.

Another important topic that he talked about is how his

time as a teacher influences how he will guide the school. When he was a teacher, he taught struggling students and rowdier classes. As he put it himself, "Just because

vou break a rule

doesn't mean vou're bad, doesn't mean I have to flip out at you... just because you're failing class doesn't mean you're stupid, means we've got to figure out a way to help you learn." He

knows that not everyone who finishes high school will go to a university, and he doesn't think any less of those who don't.

Overall. we're looking to Dr. Smith's forward leadership here at Westlake. has a welcoming personality and understands students. The ideas and goals Dr. Smith is bringing to his new position will make Westlake that much better.
